ON SITE DRESS CODE

As discussed at the Admissions meetings, there is an expectation that parents joining the school will follow the ethos of the school with regard to Shomri Shabbos, Kashrus and Tznius.

The children will be learning aspects of Halacha throughout the year, and it is very confusing if they are taught something in school which is then not adhered to at home.

All adults coming on site are reminded that to comply with the Orthodox Jewish Ethos there is a dress code when coming onto the school premises. Women should wear dresses/skirts to at least knee level, with elbow length sleeves and appropriate necklines. Men should ensure that their head is covered when on school premises and should not wear vest-type tops.

BJPS parents encompass a wide variety of families within the community and parents are asked to be respectful of one another. We ask that there is compliance with the aspect of the respectful way of dressing when entering the school grounds for any type of event.

We want all families to integrate but this is dependent upon mutual respect.

All visitors/ contractors will be informed of the School's dress code in advance. In school there are spare items of clothing that can be handed out to avoid difficulties.
